QGC funds new ute for Biloela PCYC

The Biloela Police and Citizens Youth Club has taken delivery of a new dual cab ute following a successful application for funding through QGC's \$6 million Sustainable Communities Fund.

QGC's Vice President Corporate, Brett Smith, said the \$34,000 investment was part of the company's broader contribution to local communities from Gladstone to the Western Downs.

The ute will be used to tow the PCYC's entertainment trailer for activities including discos, games nights, camps and other social events.

"QGC recognises the need for organised activities for young people in remote and regional areas," Mr Smith said.

"I'm sure the ute will be put to good use as the PCYC takes a broad range of activities to all parts of the Banana Shire.

"The QGC Sustainable Communities Fund ensures communities positively benefit from the company's presence and, through the grants assessment panel in each region, allows the community a direct say in how we invest in local activities."

The next funding round will open on 1 February 2012 and close on 31 March 2012.
